



## **NETSPAR THEME GRANTS OF €250,000.-**

Netspar is a European network for research and education in the field of pensions, aging and retirement. It is an independent network of academics and practitioners in the field, supported by Dutch universities and private and public institutions that share a keen interest in Netspar's research topics. Researchers of seven Dutch universities, international scientists as well as representatives of insurance companies, pension funds, government bodies and supervisors are affiliated with the network.

Every year, Netspar allocates theme-based grants; these annual grants are given for a three-year period. As of 2008 these grants are also available for researchers that are not affiliated with one of the (Dutch) partner universities, up to a maximum of €250,000.-
